

Action to denounce Berlusconi's ways with Naples in Brussels

Dear Monica Frassoni and Roberto Musacchio,

I contact you on behalf of GAIA –Global Alliance for Incineration Alternatives- regarding an event that together with the Italian organization Ambiente Futuro we would like to organize in Brussels in order to denounce the situation in Naples, especially in view of last measures adopted Berlusconi in which he criminalizes public participation.

We have doubts on whether the decree-law on Naples from Berlusconi is something that we should bring to the European Court of Human rights but for sure we believe we should denounce the situation in the European media.

What we propose is:

- 1- Organisation of a shooting of the documentary about Naples: "Biutiful Country" in Strasbourg the same week as the plenary vote on second reading of the Waste Framework Directive -16-19<sup>th</sup> of June-. Below you can find more info about the movie.
- 2- Press conference right after the movie denouncing how the problem in Naples started in Berlusconi's time –as the movie says, since 1994 the government appoints the responsables for waste in Campania-.
