Lots of things are happening and a lot more will come. Just a short update.

- 1- The letter from the doctors associations has been sent to MEPs together with a press release from HCWH and GAIA highlighting this issue.
- 2- We have launched the cyberaction whereby people from all over the world are right now writing to MEPs to ask them to reconsider their position in english, French, Italian, Spanish and catalan. Don't forget to sign in and forward the action to your friends!
- 3- Tomorrow morning we are publishing the letter on conflicts of interests of rapporteur Jackson who has been receiving money from the waste industry and breaching EP protocols.
- 4- We will be sending a public letter together with EEB, FoE, Bankwatch and probably GreenPeace denouncing the situation.
- 5- We will have a showing of the movie "beautiful cauntri" about the Waste crisis in Campania and together with some friendly MEPs we will denounce the result of the WFD vote.

About the policies:

All the amendments we wanted have been retabled.

It looks like the german conservatives will be asking to support stronger recycling targets. We will be working to convince other groups in the EP to move into conciliation with this amendment passed.

The debate of the WFD in the plenary will take place on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> in the late afternoon and the final vote will be either Monday evening or Tuesday morning.

I guess I'm forgetting things but as you can see we are fully involved in the process and we can start to feel the impact of our actions with replies from MEPs. 4 days to turn this around!!
